MATERIAL	HOW TO PREPARE	DO NOT INCLUDE
NEWSPAPER Dry newsprint	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Keep clean and dry</li> <li>• Place in paper bag</li> <li>• Separate from magazines</li> </ul>	Catalogs, phone books, unwanted mail, plastic wrappers or glossy inserts
GLOSSY MAGAZINES Magazines with glossy covers and pages	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Keep clean and dry</li> <li>• Separate from newsprint and other paper</li> <li>• Put loose in container</li> </ul>	Phone books, Readers Digest, TV Guide, other non-shiny magazines
METALS Aluminum, steel and bimetal food and beverage containers	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Labels and lids okay</li> <li>• Empty &amp; rinse</li> </ul>	Plastic lids, scrap metal, food residue
GLASS Clear, green and brown glass food and beverage containers	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Rinse</li> <li>• Remove and dispose of lids</li> <li>• DO NOT BREAK</li> </ul>	Ceramics, mirrors, crystal, milk glass, dishes, light bulbs, TV tubes, window & auto glass
PLASTIC BOTTLES ONLY Only plastic bottles with a narrow neck and a #1 or # 2 in the recycling symbol on the bottom	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Rinse</li> <li>• Remove and dispose of lids</li> <li>• Flatten if possible</li> </ul>	Ice cream buckets, yogurt containers, plastic lids, pesticide & chemical containers; plastics with code numbers 3-7
OLD PHONE BOOKS Realtor-Multi List Book	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Loose in container</li> <li>• Pages same quality as newspaper</li> </ul>	No plastic wrap, hard back books or staples
CORRUGATED CARDBOARD (ONLY)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Flatten</li> </ul>	NO PASTEBOARD BOXES Example: Cereal Boxes
WHITE PAPER	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Deposit in appropriate bin (See attendant)</li> </ul>	Junk mail, books
MIXED PAPER		
SCRAP METAL ONLY Cast iron, aluminum, tin, steel and copper	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Call attendant for information</li> </ul>	No Freon-example, refrigerators, air conditioners, dehumidifiers or porcelain
USED MOTOR OIL, HYDRAULIC OIL & TRANSMISSION FLUID (From residential sources)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Place used motor oil in a sealable container (limit-five gallon maximum per day)</li> </ul>	No other liquid
USED ANTIFREEZE \$1.25 per gallon or less	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Place antifreeze in a sealable container</li> </ul>	No other liquid
YARD WASTE Tree & Brush Grass & Leaves	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Fee charged per cubic yard – Contact Recycling Center</li> </ul>	No commercial material NO STUMPS
