### WINTER INFORMATION

Conway Residents are reminded that **snow is to be removed from their sidewalks immediately after, and not later than within 24 hours after snowfall.**

**Sidewalks shall be kept open and unobstructed at all times to the public.**

**Please use off-street parking during snowstorms so that the roads may be plowed thoroughly.**

**PennDOT and the Borough of Conway urge residents to:**

- Never shovel snow onto public roads.
- Shovel snow away from roadway, not toward it.
- Be cautious when working near a roadway.
- When clearing the end of the driveway, place snow to the right to prevent it from being plowed back into the driveway.
- Do not pile snow in areas that will block or obscure a driver's view of the roadway and oncoming vehicles.
- Keep children away from the roadway. Parents and guardians should keep their children from playing on snow piles near the roadway that could be plowed during snow removal operations.

### EMERGENCY INFORMATION NEEDED

- The Beaver County Emergency Management Agency sent a mailing out in December to all residents of Beaver County requesting a response from those with Special Needs. This information is necessary to help those in our community who would not be able to evacuate their homes in the case of an emergency. Conway residents are also asked to note any other Special Medical Conditions, such as those that require the use of electricity, on this card so that if Duquesne Light ever experiences an extended period of time with the electricity out of service in our borough EMA can check on you. **If you have Special Needs and did not already send in your response, please do so at this time.** Contact the Secretary's Office if you need a copy of the response card.

# CHANGE IN WATER SHUT-OFF POLICY

## For unpaid Water/Sewer Bills

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that starting with the 3<sup>rd</sup> Quarter 2014 water and sewer billing:

- Delinquent accounts will have a shut-off notice hung on their door 5-10 days after the due date. Delinquent Notices will no longer be mailed.
- The water service will be turned off within 3-5 days of the notice if the account is still delinquent. Turn-off and turn-on fees shall be added to the account.

## Water and Sewer bills are due:

January 31

April 30

July 31

October 31

Ord. No. 402, approved 10-8-1984: All water rates shall be payable quarterly on or before the 10th day of the month in which the bill is rendered, and upon failure to make payment before the first day of the month following the rendering of the bill for water, the Supervisor or other persons designated by Council shall thereupon shut off the supply of water of the delinquent consumer, and the same shall not be turned on again until the water rates and penalty of such consumer are paid in full and a fee, as established by resolution of Council, for shutting off and turning on the water has been paid.
