**Conway Residents are reminded that snow and ice is
to be removed from their sidewalks immediately after,
and not later than within 24 hours after snowfall.**

Sidewalks shall be kept open and unobstructed at all times to the public.

**Please use off-street parking during snowstorms so that the roads
may be plowed thoroughly.**

PennDOT and the Borough of Conway urge residents to:

- Never shovel snow onto public roads.
- Shovel snow away from roadway, not toward it.
- Be cautious when working near a roadway.
- When clearing the end of the driveway, place snow to the right to prevent it from being plowed back into the driveway.
- Do not pile snow in areas that will block or obscure a driver's view of the roadway and oncoming vehicles.
- Keep children away from the roadway. Parents and guardians should keep their children from playing on snow piles near the roadway that could be plowed during snow removal operations.

STREETS AND SIDEWALKS

- The owner or owners of property or properties in front of which sidewalks have been laid shall at all times maintain and repair said sidewalks and keep the sidewalks and the space between the curb and the property line in front of their property or properties clean and clear from all dirt, rubbish, garbage, refuse matter, brush, encroachments or obstructions, etc., of whatsoever nature and kind.

WATER RATES: Effective January 1, 2016 Resolution No. 122115-1

SEWER RATES: Effective January 1, 2016 Resolution No. 122115-2

THESE RATES WILL START WITH YOUR APRIL 2016 WATER AND SEWER BILLING.

STANDARD RATES: All domestic, commercial, industrial & other establishments having metered service.

GALLONS PER QUARTER

WATER RATES: For the first 1,000 gallons per quarter or less:

5/8	\$32.91
¾	\$43.83
1	\$65.79
1 ½	\$131.60
2	\$235.09

FOR EACH ADDITIONAL 1,000 GALLONS OR PART THEREOF PER QUARTER: \$7.22

SERVICE CHARGE: A \$1.06 service charge is added to the total bill per quarter.

SEWER RATES:

Minimum Rates:

Residential Buildings:	\$63.79
Commercial Establishments:	75.41
Industrial & Public Users:	180.37

Sewer Rental Rates:

Water Use/Quarter (gallons)	
1,000 or less:	Minimum Rate
Each additional 1,000 or part thereof:	\$7.09
Flat Rate Customers:	\$136.18

PENALTIES:

If bills are not paid by the due date, the Borough will add a 10% penalty. The Borough will accept without penalty remittance bearing local postmarks of the last day for payment.

SHUT OFF:

Water will be shut off if the bill is not paid within thirty (30) days after the end of the quarter. A \$50.00 shut-off fee will be charged. Water will be turned on again after account is paid in full plus an additional \$50.00 turn-on fee.

WATER TURN-OFF

Fee for service call to turn water on or off at customer request for internal piping repairs and for request by customer for disconnection and turn-on:

(a) during regular hours	\$25.00
(b) after regular hours	\$50.00

Prevent Sewer Back-ups and costly plumbing repairs
