FREE PAPER SHREDDING EVENT

State Rep. Robert Matzie will be hosting a free shredding event for constituents to safely dispose of confidential, unwanted documents from 10 a.m. to 1 p.m. on Saturday, May 18 at the Walter Panek Park in Ambridge.

Common types of unwanted items that should be shredded include credit card statements, credit card applications, bank statements, canceled checks, income tax information, insurance records and retirement or pension fund information. Please remove any paperclips and binder clips.

Attendees are encouraged to bring non-perishable or canned goods that will be donated to the area food banks.

There is a limit of no more than five bags or boxes per person. Paper will be shredded on site and recycled.
