On behalf of all of Conway, Congratulations to Conway's Jimbo Covert for his 2020 Pro Hall of Fame Induction.

Jimbo was born and raised in Conway, and graduated from Freedom High School in 1977. In Jimbo's words, what comes to his mind when someone says Conway is "HOME."

Jimbo has had a phenomenal career in football. After Freedom High School graduation, he attended and graduated from Pitt University, and was drafted in the first round of the 1983 NFL Draft by the Chicago Bears.

Jimbo's football highlights and awards include: being a Superbowl XX Champion; 100 greatest Chicago Bears of all time; 2x Pro Bowl; 2x First Team All Pro; Second Team All Pro; NFL 1980s All Decade Team; Consensus All American; Walter Camp Alumni of the Year; PFWA All-Rookie Team; Pittsburgh Panthers – Jersey #75 Retired.

Jimbo has also been inducted into: Beaver County Sports Hall of Fame; College Hall of Fame; National Italian American Sports Hall of Fame; Western PA Interscholastic Athletic League Hall of Fame, PA Sports Hall of Fame. He has been nominated on numerous occasions and will now be inducted into the Pro Football Hall of Fame.

Jimbo is married with three children, and now has a successful career focused in healthcare.

BEAVER COUNTY REASSESSMENT PROGRAM

Please be advised, Beaver County in concert with Tyler Technologies, Inc. has initiated a plan to begin data collection, for purposes of the countywide reassessment. Data collectors will be visiting and collecting information relative to individual properties beginning July 2. Collection is expected to be conducted within three weeks; however, the process will continue until July 2021.

- All data collectors will carry identification, including badges with their names and affiliation with the reassessment.
- Hours of operation will take place between 8 am and 5 pm.
- No data collector will request or otherwise attempt entry to the interior of any improvement.

WHEN CUTTING YOUR GRASS PLEASE REMEMBER:

- Grass is not to exceed six (6) inches in height.
- Grass clippings are defined as <u>refuse</u>, and are NOT to be blown into the street, and are NOT to be swept down into the storm drains.
- Do not dump bags of grass onto vacant properties, or onto mulch piles. Rotting grass in the summer produces a noxious odor and is a violation of the nuisance ordinance, which is punishable by a fine.

To protect neighbors, communities, the agriculture industry and PA's business vitality, everyone needs to be aware of the SLF threat. Information can be found at agriculture.pa.gov/spottedlanternfly

or on the Conway Borough Website.

Borough Permits are required for:

- Fences, sheds, garages/carports and swimming pools
- Porches and decks with roofs
- Decks that are 31" or more above ground level
- Retaining walls higher than 47"
- Dumpsters placed on the Borough streets
- Door-to-door soliciting (religious and political activities are exempt)
- Temporary signs (home repair companies, political, special event) you also must have permission from the property owner to place a sign if it is not on your property. It is illegal to post signs on telephone/streetlight poles per PA State laws.

This list is not all-inclusive. Other permits may be necessary.

Permit applications are available at the Borough Secretary's Office or on the borough website.

Storm sewers on the streets are a direct line to the Ohio River, which is a drinking water source for many. Rain water flowing through the storm sewers is not treated at the Sewage Plant.

REFUSE/RECYCLING PICKUP

Plastic bags and glass will not be accepted in recycling. Grocery-type bags may be recycled at most stores. Glass is to go in trash. Mattress/box springs: For the worker's protection, wrap items in plastic and tape securely closed with duct or packing tape. Limbs/branches: must be securely tied in bundles not exceeding 3" in diameter and 48" in length and weighing no more than 40 lbs. Electronic Waste: E-waste items including but not limited to: TV's and computers, monitors, keyboards, mouse, printer, etc. No more than one (1) item will be collected from any residence on any single occasion. Play it safe this summer!! Remember these rules:

- Make sure children learn basic water safety tips.
- Learn how to swim and teach your children how to swim.
- Keep children away from pool drains, pipes and other openings.
- Be alert when people are in your pool.
- Understand the basics of life-saving techniques so you can assist in a pool emergency.
- Use self-closing and self-latching gates so little ones especially cannot get into the pool when you're not there.
- Never put a dive into shallow water.
- Use the buddy system.
- Swim safely and unimpaired.
- Teach children what to do in case of an emergency. Always keep a portable phone nearby.

CURFEW

Conway Ordinance No. 440 adopted 12/14/1992
"It shall be unlawful for any minor (person less than 18 years of age) to remain in or upon any public place in the Borough of Conway after hours (from 10:00 pm to 6:00 am) unless accompanied by a parent or upon an errand or other legitimate business directed by written consent of a parent or unless engaged in gainful, lawful employment after hours, in which case said minor shall carry written identification and evidence of employment."

Conway Borough maintains four parks and playgrounds for local children to enjoy and to play safely off of the streets. Please Note - Conway Borough cannot routinely sanitize playground equipment as recommended by the CDC during the COVID-19 crisis. Social Distancing guidelines list playgrounds as places to avoid for your child's safety. Parks may still be used for outdoor exercise.

- Buttermore Park on 3rd Avenue at Fowler Street
- <u>Catherine Drive Park</u> at the end of Catherine Drive
- Gratty Park on Gross Street
- Municipal Building Park at 9th & 2nd Ave*
- -All four parks have basketball hoops for practicing shots or for a pick-up game.
- -Gratty Park also has a handicap swing, and a Skate Park for skateboards, roller blades, and BMX bikes.

ORAL RABIES VACCINATION AREA

NOTICE

Cooperating Federal, State, and county agencies are conducting an oral raccoon rabies baiting project in western Pennsylvania. A vaccine packet is coated or placed inside a fishmeal block, which is very tasty to raccoons. The baits are dropped from low-flying airplanes or helicopters, or by local teams on foot or in vehicles. The vaccine can NOT cause rabies.



What if I find rabies baits?

Baits should be left alone – but intact baits can be moved if they are found where children and pets play. Damaged baits should be bagged and disposed in the trash.

- Wear gloves or use a plastic bag when picking up the baits.
- Toss intact baits into a fencerow, woodlot, ditch, or other raccoon habitat areas.
- Wash your hands after any skin contact with a bait.

What if my pet eats a bait?

- A few baits are not harmful, although eating a lot may cause vomiting or diarrhea.
- Do not risk getting bitten by taking a bait away from your pet.
 Confine your pet for a couple of days, and check the area for more
- baits.
 If your pet eats a bait, avoid your pet's saliva for 24 hours, and
