- Fall Leaf Pickup—Begins October 20 and ends December 9 WEATHER PERMITTING Downtown pickup will be on Tuesdays and Uptown on Wednesdays. Leaves must be in paper bags.
- Snow Removal—Conway residents are reminded to remove snow and/or ice from sidewalks and steps within 24 hours after a snowfall. Do not shovel snow into the roadway and/or street.
- Refuse/Recycling Pickup—Plastic bags and glass will not be accepted in recycling: Grocery-type bags may be recycled at most stores. Glass is to go in the trash. Mattress/box springs must be wrapped in plastic and taped securely closed with duct or packing tape. Limbs/branches must be securely tied in bundles not exceeding 3" in diameter and 48" in length and weighing no more than 40 lbs. Electronic Waste items including but not limited to-TV's, computers, monitors, keyboards, mouse, printer etc. No more than one (1) item will be collected from any residence on any single occasion. Call Valley Waste Service at 724-843-9373 two weeks in advance to schedule an e-waste and/or household hazard waste pickup. You can also email: customerservice@valleywasteservice.com. Next regular HHW pickup is December 8, 2020.
- Permits are required for fences, sheds, garages, carports, additions and swimming pools. Permits are required for signs and door-to-door soliciting and etc (this list is not all-inclusive) Call the office for details or check our website for ordinances, permit applications and zoning laws.
