- 2. Fire Hydrant Quote (Pipelines, Inc.) There was discussion regarding the quote received from Pipelines, Inc. for two (2) fire hydrants. There was further discussion regarding a fire hydrant on Chaplin Street and a form to fill out for Youngblood Paving. After some review, the motion of Mr. Bohach, seconded by Mr. Patrick to approve the purchase of two (2) fire hydrants subject to not exceeding \$8,000.00 was unanimously carried.
